## WORLD YOUTH DAY 2011

St. Patrick's Parish is sending pilgrims to World Youth Day 2011 in Madrid, Spain in August 2011. The following is from one of the pilgrims, Victoria Kanhai.



"When I am asked, 'what does my faith mean to me', my response is that it means a lot to me. I believe in the Lord our God and I believe in my faith as much as possible. When I had difficulties, I always tried to face them on my own without anyone's help. It took me a while but I realized that I cannot always solve situations on my own. 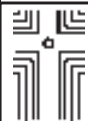
